The readings this weekend focus on the virtue of humility. Humility is defined as a low self-regard and a sense of unworthiness. The theological virtue of humility is to see oneself through God's eyes, to recognize the good and bad and still see your beauty. God does not want us to think poorly of ourselves, but to recognize that we are all sinners equal in our need for His mercy, and all brothers and sisters created in His image with an equal dignity. In our first reading from the book of Sirach, the author advises that the humble person will be loved by their fellow men and will find favor with God. In the gospel, Jesus attends a lavish meal at the home of a leading Pharisee and observes the host and guests. He gives a parable about humbly choosing a lowly seat at the banquet instead of choosing an honored seat which we might be asked to give up for another guest. He also speaks to the host and says that we should not invite those who can do something for us, but those who are outcasts and our reward will be in heaven. Let us seek what God wills for us, no more and no less, and to see ourselves through His eyes so that we will never forget how much we need Him.
