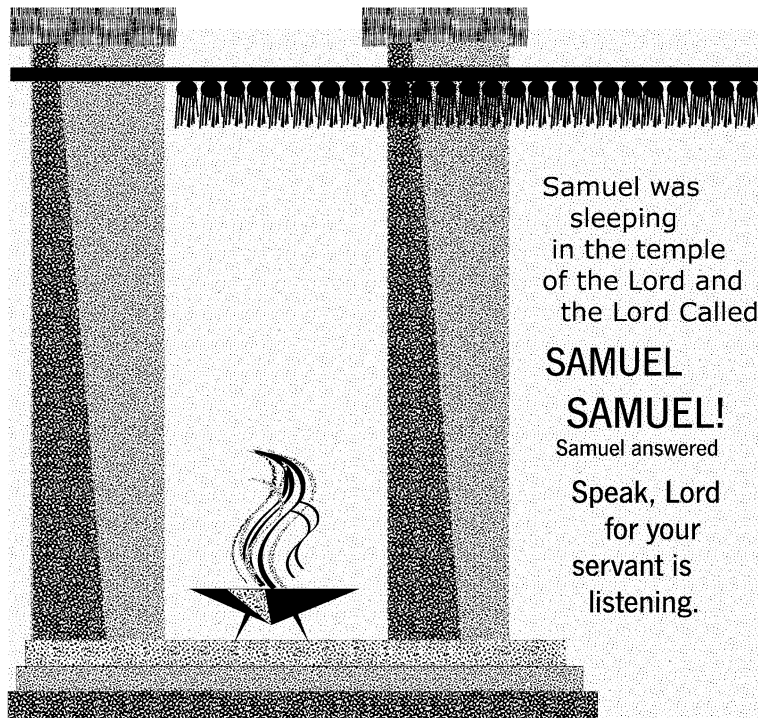
Baptism: 1st Sunday of each month after the 9:30 a.m. Mass. Contact the Pastor 3 months prior to desired date of Baptism.
