

St. Joseph Altar – Mar 12 to Mar 19, The Solemnity of St. Joseph - Special feast day during Lent – The St. Joseph Altar is an offering of love, labor and sacrifice and a reflection of deep devotion to St. Joseph, the patron of those in need. Originating in Sicily many years ago after a great drought and famine, Sicilians prayed to St. Joseph for his help and intercession for rain. Today, altars are assembled in tiers representing the Trinity and the Holy Family, Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, with a statue or painting of St. Joseph or the Holy Family placed on top along with many different cakes, breads, pastries, cookies and food offerings. Also included on the altar are the fava beans, the kind of bean people of Sicily used as their food source during the famine. Just as the people of Sicily asked for St. Joseph's help many years ago, today we also ask for St. Joseph's help and intercession and thank him for his protection. Pope Francis proclaimed **Dec. 8, 2020 to Dec. 8, 2021, as a year dedicated to St. Joseph.** Our altar is beautifully decorated this week in honor of St. Joseph, though not a typical St. Joseph Altar. Thank you to Mrs. Karen Moreau for decorating the altar.

Church Services Resume - The regular Weekday & Weekend Church Services and Holy Mass schedule are being celebrated at SHC & OLSC. Masks are mandatory unless you have a breathing difficulty (you may bring your own). We are following all restrictions stipulated by the fire marshal. **People of the Diocese of Alexandria are still dispensed from the obligation of attending any Holy Mass** but are encouraged to listen to Masses via radio or any other media.

Lenten Regulations - Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms concerning **abstinence from meat** are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. The norms on **fasting** are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Those that are excused from fast and abstinence outside the age limits include the physically or mentally ill including individuals suffering from chronic illnesses such as diabetes. Also excluded are pregnant or nursing women. In all cases, common sense should prevail, and ill persons should not further jeopardize their health by fasting.
